






























Fraction Percentage Decimal Clue A – Part One

Fraction Percentage Decimal Clue A – Answers

1. The Groups that go together are:

$\frac{1}{10}$ 10% 0.1

$\frac{1}{5}$ 20% 0.2

$\frac{1}{4}$ 25% 0.25

$\frac{1}{2}$ 50% 0.5

$\frac{9}{10}$ 90% 0.9

The five spares are:

5%  1%  0.3  $\frac{2}{5}$  $\frac{1}{3}$
